K LEA ROAD raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn, moved up to offer a bid nearing the eighth pole and proved best over JASMINE'S MELODY in the final yards. JASMINE'S MELODY was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up to gain a slight edge in mid-stretch but could not resist the winner in the drive. TRILLY KAT showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good late energy. STRATEGIC PATIENCE lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally. ROXY SKYLAR was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. LOVE TO FISH KONA broke sharply to set a pressured pace from off the rail and weakened after going a half. DAH GIFT chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after going five furlongs. JADIE CAHILL was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders throughout and gradually weakened.
