ASSESSMENT was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the quarter, opened a clear lead in mid-stretch and was all out to hold off his fast closing stable-mate in the final yards. WASSERMAN lacked early speed, began to advance from the outside through the turn, responded to steady encouragement and was gaining on the winner late. GALLON was allowed to settle in stride early, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the five-sixteenths pole, continued on through the lane and finished with good courage. ROCKINSTOMPER raced off the leaders early, moved up quickly to offer a bid nearing the nine-sixteenth marker, gained a slight edge and gave way gradually in the drive. KRUGER PARK was away alertly to set a pressured pace and gave way gradually after going a half. DIXIE MEISTER was off slow, raced far wide through the second turn and did not threaten. WAY TOO MUCH was rank to rate soon after the start, steadied nearing the seven-sixteenths pole and did not threaten. Z HUMOR was never far back while racing from off the rail and weakened after a half.
