Footnotes

RISKY ROAD lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn, responded to steady encouragement and was up in the final yards. IMPROVISOR raced unhurried early, saved ground through the second turn, moved up to take a slight edge nearing the sixteenth pole but could not hold the winner off late. POPULAR PICK was away in good order to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin into the lane and gave way through the final sixteenth. LEADERSHIP raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out and steadied nearing the quarter, angled back inside and finished evenly late. ORCAS GOLD broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. JIMMENY CREEK showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor. EXPENSES PAID chased the leaders from the outside for a half and weakened. DONELL'S DANCER pressed the pace from the outside for six furlongs and weakened.
