NINA WIN was never far back while racing along the inside and was gaining on the winner late. BURY THE HATCHET broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way to the winner in the drive. STARS ON THE WATER showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and finished evenly. NEARLY WILD broke awkwardly, raced off the pacesetters from the outside and failed to threaten.
