BEAR CREEK ROAD sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace, increased his margin approaching the stretch and was ridden out to the wire to maintain that advantage. PERUSETHENews was bumped at the start, chased the winner from the outside throughout, was no match for that foe in the drive but clearly second best. KICK THE VET was bumped repeatedly at the break, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. ASUMMERPROSPECT was bumped at the start, checked soon after, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. SILVER ROAD raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and failed to rally. KID CABIN broke sharply to chase the winner from the outside and weakened after going a half. LAACHEM was bumped repeatedly at the break, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. TENATIOUS SPIRIT was bumped repeatedly at the start, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor.
