MALIBU RUM showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, gained command with a furlong to run and quickly drew off. UGOTTABCATTY pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge inside the quarter, was no match for the winner late but held on well for the place. REZAR was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the inside, checked nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, angled out into the lane and finished with good energy. DAVOS lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. UNTILIFINDYOU was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. VEGAS FLYER hopped at the start, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. GOGGLES MCCOY was bumped at the start, rushed to take the early lead from the inside and weakened after going a half.
