MR. TOP KAT was away alertly to duel for the early advantage from the outside with CHU AND I, disposed of that rival after going a half and held sway to the wire. WILLIE THE FOX broke slow and awkward, began to advance from the inside through the turn, angled out sharply approaching the stretch and finished with good energy. IM PURE BRASS chased the leaders from the outside throughout and gave way in the drive. HILLBILLY CADILLAC raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, angled back inside nearing the sixteenth pole and finished evenly late. MO'S FLASHY DATE was never far back while racing along the inside, lacked racing room nearing the quarter, angled out and failed to gain late. R J'S PROSPECT was void of early foot, raced far wide through the turn and did not menace. CHU AND I hopped at the start, duelled for the lead from the inside and weakened after going a half. KINZIE'S KING was off a step slow, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor.
