M TWO FORTY was off a step slow, raced wide through the first turn, moved up to gain command nearing the nine-sixteenths pole, quickly opened a clear lead and increased that margin through the lane while racing in hand. RUN ATOM broke sharply to set a pressured pace, angled out nearing the quarter, drifted in and out through the stretch, was no match for the winner but clearly second best. SMOKENOMORE lacked early speed, saved ground through the second turn, angled out approaching the stretch and finished evenly in the drive. DIAMOND PEAK was bumped at the break, raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the second turn and finished with some late run. WILD W B T showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and failed to menace. MURRAY THE COP was bumped at the start, steadied soon after, raced off the pacesetters, moved outside through the second turn and lacked the needed rally. JAMES pressed the pace from the outside for a half and weakened. G TEN showed brief speed, weakened and was eased through the lane.
