D DEVIL stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command into the lane and quickly drew off. HICKORY ROAD showed no early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths pole and finished with good energy. J. H. COMMANDER broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way to the winner after going a half. HE'S ALWAYS RIGHT raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and failed to rally. ONLY BE CAUSE raced off the pacesetters from the outside throughout and did not reach contention. ROARING TO GO was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and weakened after a half. BIG SKY VATTI showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not threaten.
