TWEETIE PIE was away alertly to set a pressured pace, responded when challenged by LONELY AND FREE nearing the half, vied with that rival through a prolonged drive and proved best. LONELY AND FREE broke sharply to press the pace of the winner from the outside, moved up to engage that foe nearing the half but could not get by in the drive. LILLY'S A JEWEL lacked early speed, saved ground through the turns and finished evenly late. CALL ME CINDERELLA raced wide through the first turn, showed no early speed, angled out in mid-stretch, back inside nearing the sixteenth pole and did not threaten. ANGELS CAN BE WILD was fractious at the gate, chased the leaders from the outside for six furlongs and weakened. ALLISON RIDGE raced off the pacesetters throughout, moved far outside through the second turn and gradually weakened.
