COURTING SEATTLE was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside with PALANCA, vied with that rival into deep stretch and drew clear late. PALANCA broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside with the winner and gave way to that foe through the final sixteenth. HE'S ALWAYS RIGHT lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and finished willingly in the drive. TOLL CHARGE raced off the leaders from off the rail throughout and lacked the needed closing response. BLACKJACK KETCHUM chased the leaders from the outside and gave way after going a half. DEVINE STYLE raced off the leaders from the outside and failed to rally. DATURA showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor.
