Footnotes

TWO INTENT was never far back while racing from the outside, responded when set down for the drive and was up in the final yards to prevail. BANKERS YEAR stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge nearing the five-sixteenths marker and gave way grudgingly to the winner late. TOP THREAT was void of early speed, moved up from the far outside to be within striking distance in mid-stretch but failed to sustain his rally. SPLIT THE CHECK raced off the leaders from the outside, moved inside into the lane, jumped the fallen rival inside the sixteenth pole and was not urged in. SEAMS FUNNY lacked early speed, raced wide through the run, avoided the fallen horse while not in contention and was not urged late. REASON TO RECKON was away alertly to duel for the lead for the opening quarter and weakened. GOLD COLONY broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and weakened after three-quarters. REGALO DE LALUNA showed no early speed, raced off the rail into the lane, moved between foes while rallying with a sixteenth to run, fell, unseating his rider and was vanned off.
