VEGAS QUEEN was bumped at the start, allowed to settle, moved between foes approaching the stretch, gained command inside the furlong marker and was in hand to the wire. TENAKEE TANGO stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command with five-sixteenths to run, opened a clear lead but could not match strides with the winner late. RAGING WILDCAT lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled outside nearing the three-sixteenths marker and found her best stride late. NOTHING IN COMMON went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way after a half. REGAL SIS chased the leaders from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch and lacked the needed closing response. CLASSIC ROX raced off the pacesetters early, was pushed out nearing the quarter and did not menace in the drive. BUTTON EM UP was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the outside, drifted out nearing the quarter and failed to threaten.
