Footnotes

LONG TRIP ALONE raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, responded to steady urging and was up with a rush to prevail late. PHIL THE BOOT was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up to engage PERFECT FINISH with a quarter to run, gained a slight edge late and just failed to last. PERFECT FINISH broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, met the bid of PHIL THE BOOT nearing the quarter, yielded to that rival and checked slightly in the final yards. PARKBENCH was void of early speed, raced off the rail throughout and found his best stride late. PRIMARIUS was never far back while racing from off the rail and finished evenly in the drive. ROYAL SHRINE was void of early speed, saved ground throughout and failed to menace. DOCTOR PAV showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. OLIVERQUIGLEY raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and gradually weakened.
