DOCTOR BRUCE S. went to the front soon after the start, saved ground while setting the pace, increased his margin into the lane, drifted in and out from sticking through the final furlong and held sway to the wire. SLEW THE CAT chased the winner from the outside throughout, could not reach that foe in the drive but finished with good courage to re-gain the place. FIRST LAST CHANCE was never far back, raced far wide through the turn, reached a contending position in mid-stretch and finished evenly late. WATCH THE ROAD chased the leaders from off the rail throughout and gave way in the drive. GONE CLEVER chased the winner from the outside and gradually weakened. CHUPETES lagged throughout.
