FABADABADO broke sharply to duel for the early advantage from the outside, opened a clear lead nearing the five-sixteenths marker and drew off through the lane. JURY DUTY lacked early speed, raced between foes into the stretch and was up for the place. ALWAYS A ROSE was fractious at the gate, broke a step slow, raced off the rail into the lane and finished willingly. PEPE LE FEU showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly late. STITCHY was away alertly to press the pace from between foes and gave way in the drive. BLACKBERRY HILL dueled for the lead from the inside for a half and weakened.
