KAFWAIN SECRET M D lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn, reached the fore with a furlong to run and quickly drew off. JUST JOKIN AROUND was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, angled inside nearing the three-sixteenths pole and finished with good energy. EVIL URGES was bumped at the start, moved up quickly to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin nearing the five-eighths pole and gave way in the drive. FLYING JACK raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn and finished with a steady bid. STELLAR BLUE chased the leaders from the inside for six furlongs and weakened. TURNTABLE BAY broke sharply then was hustled along to press the pace from the inside and weakened after three-quarters. SIX GIGS broke slow and outward, showed no early speed and did not reach contention. OUR MARSHAL CAHILL was bumped at the start, forwardly placed early, raced wide through both turns and gradually weakened.
