HENNESSY GOD broke in stride to take command at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail while setting the pace, increased his margin into the lane and was ridden out to the wire. KAS CAN DANCE chased the winner from between rivals, was no match for that foe in the drive but held on well to save the place. SMOKEY M J raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, gained a contending position in mid-stretch but lacked the needed closing response. WARREN'S A LEGEND raced off the leaders early, moved between foes nearing the sixteenth pole and finished with some late run. COURAGEOUS TEJAS chased the leaders from the inside for five furlongs and weakened. SPIKER chased the winner from the outside for a half and weakened. CHARLES ANDREWS showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. ZERO SIXHUNDRED was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor.
