Footnotes

LUNA TICK stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the quarter and drew clear. MY BOY BUTCH broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside, could not stay with the winner in the drive but finished with good energy. GILMORE was never far back while racing from off the rail, steadied nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with a solid late rally. U O ME was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside, gave way to the winner but stayed on well in the drive. JUSTA GUSTA was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters early, moved far wide through the turn and finished evenly. WHISKEYONTHEHOUSE broke in, raced wide through the turn and found his best stride late. DIAMOND PEAK was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and failed to rally. BRACERO hopped at the start and was bumped, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor. GIDAPPY lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and did not offer a bid. K P BRILLY was bumped at the break, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention.
