ARCHATRAVE stalked EDNEATOR racing three deep, moved up to make his bid entering the stretch, and was all out to wear down that foe. EDNEATOR pulled clear to dictate terms, battled gamely every step but was denied in the final jump. WEEKENDER chased the pace along the inside, held well for the show, but lacked the needed rally to threaten the top two. VERNON INVADER made a steady advance through the second turn to close the gap, but failed to menace. CROWNING MEETING settled racing in hand along the inside, but faltered into the lane and faded. DASH EIGHT raced four wide in mid pack, but tired entering the stretch. MY CONSTANT STAR was outrun. APRIL SURPRISE was jostled at the start getting away slowly, and never recovered.
