Footnotes

HE'S FLYIN HOME stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage WHO'S YOUR NEXT EX with a furlong to run and proved best over that rival through the final yards. WHO'S YOUR NEXT EX went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace, met the bid of the winner in mid-stretch and gave way grudgingly to that foe late. BIG DADDY'S VISION was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. WHITNEY BRIDGE raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn, angled out further into the lane and finished evenly. OVERTIME VICTORY lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with some late run. SNAKE ATTACK raced just off the leaders from the inside and gradually weakened. TROPICAL HEAT lacked early speed, saved ground into the stretch and showed a mild bid. CERTIFIED DIAMOND reared at the start and raced far back throughout.
