MAGOO CAN DO dueled for the lead racing two wide from between horses, battled gamely through a prolonged drive, and gamely edged clear late. OATMAN GOLD dueled for the lead racing three wide, was unable match strides with the winner late, but continued on willingly to clearly prove second best. HEY NINETEEN was rank to place racing between horses, angled out to be clear, and finished fairly well to earn the show. PREMIER DIABLO was allowed to settle into stride, angled out to make a mild rally, but failed to seriously threaten. DON'T TELL SHAWN chased the pace racing four wide and went evenly. OTIS OF ATLANTIS was unhurried early, came five wide to make a mild bid, but lacked the needed late response. HE'S A BARN RAT saved ground to no avail. NAUTICAL CANDY prompted the pace racing along the inside, was caught in tight and steadied near the three-eighths pole, and showed little thereafter.
