Footnotes

MIGHTY ALL STAR broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear lead in mid-stretch while drifting out and held D DEVIL at bay to prevail. D DEVIL stalked the leaders from off the rail throughout, moved to within striking distance of the winner inside the furlong marker but could not get by that rival in the drive. LITTLE RED EAGLE was away alertly to press the pace from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. TILLMAN'S IMAGE raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn, angled outside in mid-stretch and failed to gain late. HAVIN A GOOD DAY bobbled at the break, lacked early speed, angled outside approaching the stretch and lacked the needed closing response. ORE BRAIN was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside and did not reach contention. FORT YATES was void of early speed, saved ground throughout and did not offer a bid. MR. MAKAH showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn, moved inside nearing the eighth pole and was not a factor. BUCKSHOT WEST raced off the leaders from between foes, steadied nearing the five-sixteenths pole, angled outside into the lane and did not offer a bid.
