Footnotes

CYBER BELL was never far back while racing along the inside, moved up to take command with a furlong to run and held off the closing tandem of CALIFORNIA COLONEL and PASTA TIME. CALIFORNIA COLONEL broke sharply to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the eighth pole and finished with a late surge in the closing yards to be gaining on the winner late. PASTA TIME bobbled at the break, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and was also gaining late. READY SET GLO was off slow, raced wide through the second turn and finished with some late run. RAINIER sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, vied with CRAZY WAGER after going three furlongs and gave way after going three-quarters. CRAZY WAGER pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the five-eighths marker and weakened after six furlongs.
