### Footnotes

PERFECT PIE was away alertly to stalk the pace of ALL THE RAGE from off the rail, moved up to take command inside the quarter and drew off through the lane. OUTING MAIL was never far back while racing from off the rail, angled out into the stretch and finished with good energy. GHOST TREE lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further into the lane and finished with a late rally. AKINA raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn, was bumped nearing the sixteenth pole and finished with good courage when set down late. CHAMPALI LACE was never far back, raced wide through the turn and lacked the needed late response. ALL THE RAGE sprinted clear soon after the start, saved ground while setting the pace and weakened after going five furlongs. MIRROR POND lacked early foot, saved ground into the stretch, bumped with AKINA nearing the sixteenth pole and did not threaten thereafter. SHEEN FALLS showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not threaten.
