WAY TO GO LO was away in good order to stalk the dueling leaders from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the three-sixteenths pole, quickly opened a long lead and increased that advantage as the easiest of winners. CHIPS INDY SALSA raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out in mid-stretch and was up for the place. PLUM NAKED dueled for the lead from the inside, yielded to the winner after going a half and continued on to just miss the runner-up award. ONE SMART GIRL lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and found her best stride late. BLAST'SDOUBLEDEUCE broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way in the drive. PEAKABOOTDREAM lagged early, raced far wide through the turn and failed to menace. MT PEAK raced off the pacesetters from the far outside and gradually weakened.
