JACK THE PIRATE raced unhurried early, saved ground through the turn, angled out approaching the stretch, reached the fore with a furlong to run and won with something left. ORCAS GOLD was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside, was no match for the winner in the drive but finished well to hold the place. CHARMING BUDHA broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way in the drive. TAHOE'S PRIZE bobbled at the break, raced off the pacesetters from the outside and failed to rally. VAN GLORIOUS chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. GALWAY GUINNESS raced far wide through the turn and lagged throughout.
