ALFURUNE was allowed to settle into stride, responded when roused leaving the three-eighths pole, came four wide into the lane, caught TURBAN nearing the furlong marker, and steadily pulled clear. POKER BRAD stalked the pace racing along the inside, was blocked and waited briefly in traffic leaving the second turn, angled out to find room and finished willingly once clear. SKIP TO THE STONE sent hard to press the pace racing along the inside, weakened entering the lane, but dug in gamely through the drive to preserve the show. Following the race SKIP TO THE STONE was unsaddled near the three-quarter pole and was vanned off. TURBAN settled racing in hand, made a bold middle move racing three wide to vie for the lead, forged command briefly between calls entering stretch, but failed to sustain the bid and gave way. SMOKEY SESSION passed only his tiring rivals. SABERTOOTH set the pressured pace racing along the outside of SKIP TO THE STONE, but was collared from between horses leaving the five-sixteenths pole and stopped. SALT GRINDER was through after a half.
