DOCTOR DECEPTION broke in stride to take command at once, set a pressured pace until the three-sixteenths marker, quickly drew clear and held off the closing JAMALOUIE to prevail. JAMALOUIE showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and was gaining on the winner late. IM PURE COUNTRY was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished with good courage. BOX TOP dueled for the lead from the inside for a half and gave way. TRUE MUSIC raced off the leaders from the inside and lacked the needed closing response. WINDSONG AT LAST was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to threaten. CHARLIE AT LAST was bumped at the start, saved ground into the stretch and was not a factor. COAL MAN was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside for three furlongs and weakened.
