Footnotes

CERTIFIED DIAMOND raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out into the lane, reached the leaders with a furlong to run and quickly drew off. BUDS A FLYIN chased the leaders from the inside throughout, could not match strides with the winner in the drive but held on well to save the place. FAST TRADE broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way late. HE'S TICKLED was away alertly to press the pace from the outside and gave way in the drive. LIBERTY AT THE BAR was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, drifted inward nearing the eighth pole and finished evenly thereafter. VITAMIN C was bumped at the start, lagged early, raced off the rail into the lane and did not menace. RAINIER lacked early foot, steadied nearing the five-sixteenths pole and did not threaten in the drive. BOYO raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and weakened after going a half.
