ATTA BOY ROY broke sharply to duel for the early advantage from the outside with MARGO'S GIFT while under steadying restraint, disposed of that rival into the lane and held off the closing stable-mates through the final furlong to prevail. ASSESSMENT was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders, checked when drifting in nearing the eighth pole, was quickly straightened away and finished with good courage. WASSERMAN showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished full of run to be gaining late. TRITIUM broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside throughout and gave way in the drive. REEL PRIME was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground into the stretch, angled outside in mid-stretch and finished evenly. MARGO'S GIFT was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and gave way after going a half.
