### Footnotes

DARE ME DEVIL broke sharply to press the pace of REZAR from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge nearing the quarter, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run and held off the closing WASSERMAN to prevail. WASSERMAN lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and was up for the place. UGOTTABCATTY was never far back, saved ground through the second turn, angled out into the stretch and finished with good energy. REZAR was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way after going three-quarters. LESSON IN DECEIT was bumped at the break, lagged early, raced far wide through the second turn and was not a factor. MOMENT OF WEAKNESS (IRE) was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from between foes and weakened after going a half.
