JEWEL S. was never far back, angled out nearing the quarter, reached the fore with a furlong to run and quickly drew off. ITS DIVA TIME was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further into the lane and finished with good energy to gain the place. PORT WAKEFIELD showed no early foot, saved ground through the turn and finished with a late rally. SEATTLE GAME went to the front at once, saved ground while setting the pace, opened a clear margin before going a quarter and gave way through the final furlong. DREAM CALLER was bumped at the break, chased the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. REDSEASALT chased the leaders from the outside for a half and weakened. MONTELENA was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to threaten. BIRDIE GIRL broke sharply to stalk the leaders, moved up to take a slight edge into the lane, went wrong, was pulled up and vanned off.
