THE GREAT FACE was away alertly to dictate terms and gamely led throughout. NORM'S NEPHEW stalked the pace racing three deep, was unable to reach the winner, then was all out to just hold the place. WASSERMAN was allowed to settle into stride, came four wide to make his bid, finished willingly and was along for the show. COURTING SEATTLE attended the pace racing along the inside, got through to make a bold bid entering the stretch, but lacked the needed late response. BOUND TO BE M V P rushed up to press the pace along the inside, but weakened during the drive and faded. MR. MAKAH settled in the second flight, came four wide into the lane, but failed to respond when called upon.
