Footnotes

A BLACK THORN was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage his stable-mate with a furlong to run and was up to dead-heat with that foe through a hard drive. VICKYS FAST BOY was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the quarter, gained a slight edge with a furlong to run and held gamely to finish on even terms. MISTER LICORICE was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with a strong late rally. POLO BENDER was bumped at the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way through the final furlong. BRAINSTORM lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention.
