Footnotes

CASTLE ROMEO raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, reached THRILLER G with a furlong to run and proved best over that rival in the drive. THRILLER G was away alertly to stalk the pace of COUGAR BOB from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge inside the quarter and gave way to the winner through the final furlong. SONJA'S FIRE FLY chased the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. GETNDOWNTHELANE bobbled at the start, lagged early, saved ground through the turn and found his best stride late. COUGAR BOB hopped at the start, opened a clear margin before going a quarter, raced off the rail while setting the pace and gave way after going a half. ECLIPSING MOON raced off the leaders throughout and failed to rally. ELVIE'S BOY lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out into the lane, went wrong inside the sixteenth pole and was vanned off.
