MUSICAL WINE was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the inside, waited for racing room into the lane, reached the leaders in mid-stretch and proved best in a stiff drive. WAVE HER ON was void of early speed, moved between rivals approaching the stretch, responded when set down for the drive and finished with good energy. PHILA MIGNON broke sharply to duel for the lead from between rivals, gained a slight edge in mid-stretch but could not hold off the closers in the drive. SKY HIGH WONDER lacked early speed, saved ground into the lane, angled out nearing the eighth pole and showed some late run. THATSTHEWAYLUVGOES was away alertly to press the pace from the outside and gave way after five furlongs. TAMALE MOLLY was bumped at the start, duelled for the lead from the inside and gave way after a half. TOO CUTE TO BOOT showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to threaten. WILD R. N. raced far wide through the turn and weakened.
