Footnotes

COURTING SEATTLE stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage KINDACATCHY nearing the three-eighths pole, opened a clear lead in mid-stretch and was fully extended to hold the closers off late. HE'S ALWAYS RIGHT lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled outside nearing the sixteenth pole and finished with good late speed. SPLIT THE CHECK raced just off the leaders throughout and finished with a solid late rally. PAVAN RAJ was off slow, saved ground early, moved between foes late and finished with good late energy. PALANCA broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and gave way after going five furlongs. KINDACATCHY went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, drifted in during the drive and had to be straightened away while continuing to give way. TOLL CHARGE was pinched back at the start, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. SPUNKY HARRY was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten.
