STRATEGIC PATIENCE stalked the pace of MISS SLEWY from the inside, moved up to take command with three-sixteenths to run and drew off through the lane as a handy winner. MISS SLEWY broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside, opened a clear lead nearing the five-sixteenths marker, was no match for the winner in the drive but clearly second best. TUFF TOAD was never far back, raced wide through the turn, veered in repeatedly through the lane and finished evenly when straightened away. JOANIESWEETHARMONY was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and weakened after the opening quarter. SALLY WONDER showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and failed to menace. GAT'S BLAST lacked early foot, raced off the rail into the lane and was not a factor.
