L G'S GOLD settled saving ground, ranged into striking distance through the turn, angled out to continue the advance entering the lane, caught BEST PRACTICES inside the furlong marker, and steadily edged clear. BEST PRACTICES rushed to the lead to set the pressured pace racing along the inside, shook off SASSY LITTLE SARAH leaving the turn, but was unable to resist the winner in the final yards. DASHING LADY was rank to place while in traffic early, settled into stride through the turn, got through to make a late rally and was along in time to earn the show. ZAIRSAPLAN settled racing in hand, angled out to make a mild late gain, but failed to seriously threaten. SILVER SHOT chased the pace racing three wide for a half and faltered. SASSY LITTLE SARAH pressed the pace for a half and stopped. FREETOBE ME was fractious in the gate, showed little in a dull effort, was eased to the wire but walked off.
