R W DUSTY'S GIRL raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn, responded to vigorous urging and caught TRUE INDIAN in the final strides. TRUE INDIAN broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear lead into the lane but was caught late. SOMETHING SASSY broke out, lacked early speed, raced between foes and finished willingly in the drive. VIKING TRIBUNAL chased the leaders from the outside and gave way gradually. CITY COLORS lacked early speed, saved ground into the stretch, angled outside with a furlong to run and finished evenly. ARIEL ALISE hopped at the start, raced off the rail into the stretch and passed tiring foes late. SO SKIMMING ON YOU was void of early speed, raced wide into the lane and did not threaten. ARTIST'S GOLD pressed the pace from between foes and gave way after going a half. NOTES OF FREEDOM broke out, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. HOUR PRETTY GIRL pressed the pace from between foes and weakened after the opening quarter. HOLY DEUCE showed brief speed and weakened.
