**Footnotes**

BUFF ORPINGTON broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside, opened a clear lead in mid-stretch and held sway to the wire. PE ELL REV was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished with a solid late bid. THATSTHATWITHTHAT dueled for the lead from the outside with the winner throughout and gave way in the drive. LUKE STALLWALKER was never far back while racing from off the rail and lacked the needed closing response. CANVASBACK COVE raced off the pacesetters from the inside and finished evenly in the drive. FALL CITY FOG was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn, steadied while rallying late and lost chance for a better placing. MR. BIG FIG raced off the leaders early, angled out nearing the quarter and did not threaten. DIXIEDOODLEDEDE raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and did not menace. PAMIHAKA lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor. MUSICLEDO showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. T S AUSTIN lacked early foot, saved ground into the stretch and did not menace. DR. BOB pressed the pace from the outside for three furlongs and weakened.
