ASSESSMENT was never far back while racing along the inside, moved between rivals nearing the five-sixteenths marker, reached NOOSA BEACH with a furlong to run and proved best over that rival through a stiff drive. NOOSA BEACH was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace from off the rail, turned back the bid of GALLON nearing the five-sixteenths pole, responded when challenged by the winner and gave way grudgingly to that foe late. GALLON was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to engage NOOSA BEACH nearing the five-sixteenths marker and gave way in the drive. DAVOS lacked early speed, steadied nearing the nine-sixteenth pole, saved ground into the lane and finished willingly. WASSERMAN lagged early, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. MARGO'S GIFT raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished evenly. WINNING MACHINE was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside and gradually gave way. HE'S ALL HEART was away alertly to press the pace from the inside and weakened after going three furlongs.
