SPLIT THE CHECK stalked the pace of REASON TO RECKON from the inside, moved up to take command nearing the five-sixteenths marker and drew off through the lane. BANKERS YEAR lacked early speed, saved ground through the second turn, angled outside into the lane and finished with good energy. PEDRO VALDIVIA chased the leaders from the outside and lacked the needed closing response. REASON TO RECKON broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside and weakened after six furlongs. LARRYTHESTABLEGUY was never far back while racing from off the rail and finished evenly in the drive. SEAMS FUNNY showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. HE'S JOKIN' was hard to rate, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor.
