KENZIE CAROLINA sprinted clear soon after the start, saved ground while setting the pace, was well rated for the final quarter, responded when met by LADY ARAGORN and SEA SIDE STORY in tandem nearing the quarter, was headed briefly by LADY ARAGORN in mid-stretch and came back gamely to prevail over that rival through the final yards. LADY ARAGORN was away alertly to race just off the leaders, moved up from the far outside to offer a bid nearing the quarter, gained a slight edge with a furlong to run but could not match strides with the winner late. HAVE'N A WILD TIME broke sharply to gain a stalking position from the inside throughout but failed to gain in the drive. SEA SIDE STORY broke awkwardly, chased the winner from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the quarter and weakened in the drive.
