INTENTIONAL FOUL pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the quarter, opened a clear lead into the lane and was ridden out to the wire to increase that advantage. FREEDOMSLASTKNIGHT was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside, was no match for the winner in the drive but held on determinedly to save the place. TRIBAL WISH was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from between rivals throughout and just missed for the runner-up award. RAINIER broke in the air, lagged early, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. MARQUETCHING broke awkwardly and was bumped, duelled for the lead from between rivals for three furlongs and weakened.
