**Footnotes**

POWER STRIP went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear margin before going a quarter, raced off the rail while setting the pace, responded when challenged by MALTESE PINS nearing the three-sixteenths pole, vied with that rival through a vigorous drive and held gamely. MALTESE PINS stalked the winner from the outside, moved up to engage approaching the stretch, dueled through a prolonged drive and just missed. CODYS A BOBCAT raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the second turn and was up for the show. SNOW ON THE RIVER bobbled at the break, was never far back while racing from off the rail and lacked the needed rally. WILD HOSS lagged throughout.
