Footnotes

CASH GAMING was bumped at the start, dueled for the early advantage from the outside with KASINO MAN, disposed of that rival nearing the five-sixteenths marker, responded when challenged by SARBOONE nearing the quarter, vied with that rival through a prolonged drive and gamely prevailed. SARBONNE was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the quarter, dueled with the winner and just missed. KASINO MAN dueled for the lead from the inside, angled out into the lane while retreating and did not threaten thereafter. CAMP PENDLETON showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, steadied nearing the five-sixteenths pole from fallen rider and did not reach contention. SEND SILVER chased the leaders from the outside, clipped heels nearing the five-sixteenths pole and unseated his rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the clipping heels and unseating of the rider of SEND SILVER and after reviewing the films could find no fault of others.
