**Footnotes**

PACKY broke sharply to duel for the lead with SABERTOOTH from the outside, disposed of that rival nearing the quarter, opened a clear lead into the lane, turned back the bid of SPANISH HIGHWAY with three-sixteenths to run and held that rival at bay to the wire. SPANISH HIGHWAY was never far back, moved up from the outside to engage the winner into the stretch, could not get by that foe in the drive but finished with good courage. HIGH LODE was squeezed back at the start, raced off the rail into the lane and finished with good energy. MAGOO CAN DO was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and showed some late interest. SABERTOOTH dueled for the lead from the inside and gave way after a half. SCHOOLIN YOU lacked early speed, saved ground into the stretch and found his best stride late. EXCLUSIVE EAGLE raced off the rail throughout and failed to threaten. AMERICAN FURY showed no early speed, raced between foes approaching the stretch and did not reach contention. MARBURY was void of early speed, raced off the rail throughout and was not a factor. ZILLAH'S KNIGHT was never far back, raced wide through the turn and gradually weakened. SHARPSTER was off slow, raced wide through the turn and failed to offer a bid.
