Footnotes

KOALA BEACH was away alertly to stalk the pace of ORLANDO XPRESS from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the three-eighths marker, opened a clear lead with a quarter to run, increased that advantage and held off the closing SHOWMETHEMONEYJIM to prevail. SHOWMETHEMONEYJIM raced off the pacesetters from the inside, checked when lacking racing room nearing the quarter, angled out into the lane and was gaining on the winner late. SWISS LIGHTNING lacked early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and finished with a steady rally. GUZZLINGIN chased the leaders from the outside throughout and failed to gain in the drive. HUMONGOUS hopped at the start, raced far back early, angled out in mid-stretch and again at the sixteenth marker and did not threaten. ORLANDO XPRESS broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, weakened after going six furlongs and was eased late.
